

Gabriella Celeste, J.D., serves as policy director for Case Western Reserve University's Schubert Center for Child Studies and is co-director of the university's childhood studies program. Her responsibilities include supervising Schubert's child policy externship program, conducting trainings and presentations, and building partnerships that promote effective public policy and practice for the well-being of children and adolescents.

She has worked extensively with vulnerable children in various nonprofit and administrative roles, both directly and conducting applied research, evaluation and technical assistance for foundations, nonprofit and government agencies.

Celeste co-founded the Juvenile Justice Project of Louisiana in 1997 and has been instrumental in juvenile justice policy reform in Ohio. She was reappointed to the Ohio Public Defender Commission by Governor Kasich in 2015 and currently sits on the Magnolia Clubhouse Board of Directors, the Youth Risk Behavior Survey Community Advisory Board and the Cuyahoga County "Defending Childhood" Governing Board.
