



Types of Articulation Agreements

- **Completion Articulation Agreements:** This is the main or most common bilateral legal agreement that Tri-C uses. This agreement includes the future development and approval of academic major-specific transfer pathways by both institutions.
- **Major-Specific Transfer Pathways:** Each transfer pathway is an addendum to the Completion Articulation Agreement. These transfer pathways or “maps” indicate which courses students take semester by semester, allowing them to see the overall educational plan including the completion of both associate and bachelor’s degrees.
- **Dual Admission/Enrollment Agreements:** This is a legal agreement by which eligible students can be admitted to a four-year partner school while earning their Tri-C associate degree. Some allow students to enroll in courses at both schools simultaneously and utilize specified facilities and services at the four-year school.
- **Program-Specific Agreements:** This is a legal agreement for a specific academic program or for students involved in Tri-C Honors or the Mandel Scholars Program.
- **Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathways:** Standardized transfer pathways between Ohio community colleges and public four-year universities that are mandated by state law. These are similar to the major-specific transfer pathways.
